

Bull Terrier Club of America National Owner Handler Annual Award

Purpose: To encourage the participation and increase the number of owner handlers at American Kennel Club all breed and specialty dog shows and to support the American Kennel Club National Owner Handler Series.

General Rules:

An award for the top owner handled team as compiled by the American Kennel Club National Owner Handler Series (NOHS) in both colored and white varieties shall be presented each year on the Silverwood weekend. Winners to be determined by the AKC statistics of the previous year. (*see example). Award to be in the amount of \$200.00 for each team in each variety for a total of \$400.00 drawn from the general funds of the BTCA. In addition, a commemorative plaque shall be given in each variety and a page in the BTCA Record shall be dedicated to the winners (both winners on one page). BTCA Corresponding Secretary to forward winner information in each variety from the American Kennel Club to trophy chair and BTCA Record editor in a timely manner.

Trophy chair to be responsible for ordering an appropriate plaque. Cost of plaques to be the responsibility of the BTCA and approved by the BTCA sitting board of directors

Awards shall be presented each year on the Silverwood weekend at a time to be determined.
